Description: The Wells Historical Society is seeking two self-motivated individuals to coordinate the activities of the Wells Historical Society for the summer of 2016. This Society operates the Wells Museum, offers educational programs to students and the visiting public, maintains a museum collection and archives and organizes community fundraising events.

Candidates must, as per the requirements set out by the *Young Canada Works* program:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*; and,
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.

Students registered in Cooperative Education Programs are encouraged to apply. Preference given to students enrolled in history, material culture, conservation and/or museum related studies. Students who are visible minorities are encouraged to apply.
