- Workshop (25 minutes)
- Panel (50 minutes)
- Extended workshop (50 minutes)

SUBMITTING A PROPOSAL

Proposals must contain the following information:

- The title of your proposal
- Name(s) and contact details (email and phone) of those presenting
- Short biography, including organization affiliation (no more than 200 words)
- Summary of your proposal (no more than 500 words)
- Type of proposal (workshop: short/extended; presentation: individual/panel)
- Main session aims
