Two to three positions may be available; both registered Post-Secondary and High School students may apply. High School students will have access to weekend work, as well as part or full-time work in July and August. Post-Secondary students will have access to part or full-time work. Duties include: accommodation; food services; interpretation of the site, land, and buildings; retail sales, general up-keep and cleaning; and events and groups programming & services. Post-Secondary Students require a Class 5 Drivers License.
