1972.6.31	Tank, mixing tank	Moon crescent shaped steel tank with three handles: two short opposite ones, one larger one off-centre; bottom has round depression forms shallow cylinder.
1974.102.2	Can, Trash	Green square metal trash can on four feet, rolled rim top; two sides have cut-out handles centre top.
1974.92.33	Bowl, Mixing	One blue enamel bowl. The bowl has high sides and is rounded on the bottom. The top edge is turned outward and flattened forming a lip.
1976.50.2	Basin	Heavy steel and with two handles, sides slope out, black drips on sides.
1978.74.12a-b	Barrel	A small wooden barrel with two metal rings holding the pieces together, and a cork stopper in the hole.
1979.27.5	Separator, Cream	International Harvester McCormack Deering cream separator with stand.
1982.34.35	Box, Bread	Light green metal bread box: squared shape with sloping front; 2 shelves and 2 slide up doors; back: "GSW QUALITY" trademark centre top, ventilation holes centre bottom.
1985.45.6a-b	Box	Wooden container with removable lid: a) tall and narrow cylindrical container made of three wide strips of bent wood, four wooden hoops over the joints and reinforce the cylinder, vertical joints are 'sewn' with fiber strips; five vertical pieces of bamboo to centre lid in place run full height and are affixed with round metal tacks to the hooks; a long piece of twine looped through four holes on the bottom hoop to create carrying handles or to fasten the lid, one side torn off at hoop; box contains wood shavings used for packing contents; hand written in pencil: "Large China Vase / Farmers Greeting Spring", below crossed out address in Vancouver, B.C.; b) lid is two pieces of wood held together by a wooden hoop; horizontal crossbar is attached with five round metal tacks to top; "No 19 / OPEN / THIS END" stenciled in black, 3?220 handwritten in crayon.
1989.35.16a-b	Pail	a) Grey metal pail, rolled rim, loops to hold rounded handle, flares out from rounded base. b) Small metal pail, appears to be made of three pieces of metal soldered together, rolled rim. Two brackets at top with circular hole, centre, to insert metal carrying handle. Separate circular piece of metal to form base, soldered. Very faded decorative white paint ring around top.
1990.21.6a-b	tin	Silvertone metal can with removable lid: a) tall cylindrical metal can two exterior beads top, wire handles on each side affixed near top bead; bottom plain, stamped with concentric circle pattern; b) dome style cover with curl, raised edge and concentric circle pattern top, There is a separate lid which is ridged on its top and has no handle; silvertone.
1991.35.15	Crate	wooden "Schwepps" crate
1991.49.3	Separator	Five Gallon Esso Marvelube metal pail with handle and separator adaptation: red, white and blue exterior with manufacturer's printed information; interior has small metal can soldered to one side, long thin tube soldered to bottom of small can extends to

1991.49.4	Pail	Cylindrical metal container (tin?) golden colour, vertical solder on one side; no lid or handles. Two small heat spots visible on bottom.
1991.49.5	Separator	Tall cylindrical metal container with one handle, tappers to top, closed with lid (with handle); metal tap soldered to bottom.
1997.25.16	Can	Small cream coloured barrel-like can with brass thread, cap has fitting to relieve pressure, side is fitted with small round pressure gauge, wire handle. Can and lid not numbered individually.
2012.INV.224	can, food storage	Biscot Shortening 50 Lbs. can without lid: tall cylindrical metal container with exterior bead near top edge, two wire handles on sides; red oval label with product information in blue and black centre front.
2012.INV.234	box, storage	Dark stained (varnished finish) wooden box with 9 interior compartments. Vertical walls are Masonite, the remaining are plywood. One nail sits in the center of the panel at the base and is bent.
2012.INV.235	crate, storage	Wooden crate (unfinished) with open top. Corners fitted - dovetailed (square), glued and nailed. Base is nailed (butt joint) to the base of the body. One side has remains of a black ink stamp and two tobacco paper stamps (light blue and dark blue), opposite to this there is pencil handwriting that has been scratched out.
2012.INV.53	box, index card	Varnished, dark-stained oak index card box. Front has "Macey" stamped in gold just below a brass label frame with integral hook and above a small brass knob at the base. Inside is a flat insert which slides along two thin steel rods in an open slot in the base and long metal hinges
2013.INV.100	Box	Rough finish cylindrical bent wood container with wooden trim bottom; vertical joint stapled; bottom nailed through trim and walls of container.
