Bottle	Good	Liquor bottle, blue tinge glass, 31cm hi. "A" below 3 dots, below "3". Mold seams at bottom & sides of shoulder. Neck 7.5cm lg, lip 2.4cm lg. Part of white foil seal on lip & part of neck with "Special Reserve" in fancy upward slope writing.	
Bottle	Fair	Liquor, dark brown, 29.3cm tall. Base 7.3cm, concave, round W.F.S. below "II", below "MIL". Mold seams on sides of body, shoulder & neck. Markings from foil seal on lip & neck.	
Bottle	Fair	Liquor, green glass, 30.5cm hi. Mold line bottom of shoulder. Neck is 9.5cm lg, lip 1cm lg, Seal remains on lip & neck.	



Bottle	Fair	Liquor, green glass, 30.5cm hi, 7.2cm dia base, extremely concave, rounded, chipped. Neck is about 7.5cm lg, lip 2cm lg, circ. 9.5cm.		
Bottle	Good	Liquor, brown glass, 29cm hi, diam. at base 7.3cm concave round. "R & Co" & "26". Seams on body shoulder & neck. Neck 7.7cm lg, lip 2cm lg & 9.5cm . Remainder of foil on lip & part of neck.		
Bottle	Fair	Liquor, dark green glass, 28.5cm hi. Base 7.7cm dia, quite concave, round. Seam on bottom of shoulder, sides & neck. 5cm lg neck, 2cm lg lip. Remainder of foil seal on lip & neck. C.B & CO. & N embossed on base.		
Bottle	Fair	Liquor, green glass 28cm hi, 7.7cm dia, concave. N & CO & 1902 embossed on base. Circle /line 1.5cm lg on center base. Seam lines on sides, shoulder & neck. Lip 2cm lg, circ 10cm. Foil on lip & neck. Thickness uneven.		





Plane	Good	Smooth wooden planer. Some components may be missing.	
Bottle	Fair	Clear glass liquor bottle. Wide body and narrow neck. Dirty.	
Coupons	Good	Bag of 100 Nabob Foods coupons. Thin sheets of paper printed with red ink. Products range from peanut butter to coffee.	
Wrench	Fair	Long wrench with one open end and one end a long spike. Iron.	
Rail Spike	Fair	33 rusted rail spikes	
Cant Hook	Poor	Broken piece of a cant hook. This is only one half of the hook.	
Wrench	Poor	3 very rusted monkey wrenches. Various sizes	
Vise	Poor	1 heavy duty vise. The vise resembles the top half of a monkey wrench.	

Axe	Poor	1 double-bladed axe head. The handle is missing. Very scarred and marked, with a hole in the centre.	
Tie Plate	Fair	2 rusted railway tie plates	
Jar	Good	One glass jar. The outside reads "IMPROVED GEM, ". The jar has a glass lid and a metal ring around the neck.	
Jar	Good	One large glass jar. It reads "Canadian JEWEL / MADE IN CANADA."	
Book	Fair	Book entitled "ONTARIO HIGH SCHOOL ENGLISH GRAMMAR." The book is blue and hardcover, with some wear around the edges and corners.

Bottle	Fair	Glass condiment bottle with metal lid, quite rusty. Slightly dirty. The bottom reads "HEINZ / MADE / IN / CANADA."	
Ruler	Fair	Wooden folding yard stick. The stick is attached in 3 places using brass hinges, and has a brass cap on either end. The stick is printed with black ink numbers of inches and measuring lines. It reads "RABONE / MADE IN ENGLAND."	
Bit	Poor	Horse bit. The bit is a metal bar with large rings on either side. There are short bars extending down from the rings. The bit has small spots of rust all over.	
Can Lids	Fair	33 gold canning lids. Unused.	
Nails	Good	13 hand-made square nails. Some rust.	
Nail	Poor	1 rusted hand-made nail. The nail is square with a square head.	
Awl	Fair	1 wood-handled awl. The awl is stamped with "City Ice & Cold Storage Co. / (illegible) Ave. / Seattle."	
Chisel	Fair	1 wood-handled chisel. The chisel is slightly curved at the end and the handle is engraved with "W.G.E." Some rust and some white marks.	

Tools	Poor	17 assorted metal chisels, drill bits and other tools. Various sizes. Some rust.	
Saw Blade	Fair	1 jeweler's saw blade. The end is painted blue, and there is a small hole in it for hanging.	
Light Fixtures	Poor	2 ceramic parts of light fixtures. The parts are white and ring-shaped with threads in their interiors.	
Light Bulb	Good	1 small Xmas light bulb is green with a gold metal end.	
Playing Pieces	Good	4 small wooden game pieces. They are shaped like pylons. Three are natural wood-colored, and one is purple.	
Guitar Slide	Fair	1 metal guitar slide. The slide has a rectangular end and a rounded cylindrical handle. It is a solid, chrome like, polished piece of metal. Has some tape on it.	
Card	Good	1 Canadian/American Songbirds collector's card. The card has an illustration on one side of a McCown's Longspur. The opposite side has a write up in English and French about the bird. It was made by the National Wildlife Federation in 1966. This card was a free collectible item found inside Red Rose - Blue Ribbon coffee and tea.	
Bell Piece	Fair	1 small piece of a bell or a telephone handset. The piece is circular and has a rounded face with a circle of small holes drilled through it, and 2 small holes in the centre of the part.	
Crate	Poor	1 fruit crate. The crate is wooden and shallow, with indents from the tops of cans on the bottom. The end is printed with "GROWN AND PACKED BY / T. APKARIAN AND SONS / INC. / REEDLEY, CALIF. / MIN. NET WT. --- 26 LBS." The opposite end has a partial paper label with a picture of a blue background and 2 bears in front of a farm scene. The word "MOUNTAIN" is prominent.	
Plate	Poor	1 double-sided metal plate. The plate is rectangular with one rounded end. There are 4 tiny holes along either side that hold the plates together.	

Hooks	Poor	3 trace hooks- 1 large, 2 small. The hooks consist of a metal ring attached to an S-hook.	
Bottle	Good	1 small brown bottle. The bottle is round and has a narrow neck with a ring around the neck.	
Cassette Tapes	Fair	19 8-track cassette tapes. Their labels shows some staining and yellowing. Some are in cardboard packages, which show wear and creasing. Tools	Fair	10 tools with three small tines on the end. The last tine is bent forward, the middle tine is straight, and the first one is slightly bent inward. They have varying widths and sizes.	
Plane Part	Good. Partial piece of a grooving plane.	1 grooving plane wedge. The wedge is wooden and shaped like a letter opener. It is flat and has a rounded end. The other end is pointed.
