| 1975.82.139 | Sledgehammer | <p>Small Sledge Hammer; dark grey iron head, curved topped, indented circle on both sides; wood handle set into head, gets wider near the base. Printed into the underside of the head: "2".</p> |  |
| 1976.5.100 | Hammer | <p>Sledge hammer with a wooden handle narrowing in the middle and wider at the ends. The head is iron, and it is wider in the center, tapering to a flat point at one end, and a narrow rectangular striking face at the other.</p> |  |

| 1977.164.15 | Hammer, Rock | Dark grey metal head with one rounded face, other end narrow rectangle that tapers off towards the end; straight dark brown wood handle. |  |

| 1994.3.23 | Hammer | Dark grey metal head with two striking surfaces: one flat round one, other a thin rectangle; wood handle narrower near head, wider towards base. |  |

| 1994.65.1 | Hammer | <p>Dark grey metal head, rounded at the top with two flat ends; wooden handle is narrow by the metal head but gets wider towards the base.</p> |  |

| 1994.65.3 | Hammer, Face | <p>Rectangular steel block with an oblong perforation centre, one square face has 5 x 5 rows of pyramidal teeth and the other 7 X 7; initials "JB" roughly carved on the side of the block.</p> |  |
| 2001.2.9 | Hammer, Chipping | <p>Chipping hammer with a steel head on wooden handle. Head is double-faced, one face tapers to a blunt point, the other is a narrow axe face.</p> |  |

| 2005.11.20 | Hammer, Metalworking | Square metal head widens to end in circular strike face; wooden handle is set into oval eye at an angle, very close to square end; handle is very narrow where it is fitted on head and widens toward end. |  |

| 2005.11.22 | Hammer, Metalworking | Twist-face hammer with wooden handle: irregular shaped metal head with elongated hexagonal faces, triangular and pentagonal surfaces form the rest of the head; handle narrows toward the head and fits into oval hole; thin metal shim inserted on top of handle to tighten; "2 1/2" stamped next to handle on head; one corner has broken off. |  |
| 2005.11.23 | Hammer, Setting | Saw Setting hammer with thin wooden handle: head has two long cylindrical extensions, one ending in round strike plate and the other in a point; thin dark wooden handle fits into centre of head and has a metal shim inserted on top to tighten, irregular contour widens a little toward end. |  |

| 2005.11.25 | Hammer, Cross-Peen | <p>Heavy geometrical shaped head with wooden handle: Large rectangular metal block tapered vertically on one side and horizontally on the other to form two long rectangular strike faces; oval wood handle fits into centre hole and metal S-clip inserted on top to secure; handle is narrower toward head, has flat end; manufacturer's mark top edge on horizontal strike plate side barely visible, non legible; stamped "R B" centre on other side.</p> |  |

| 2005.11.26 | Hammer, Metalworking | <p>Twist-face hammer with wooden handle: irregular shaped metal head with elongated strike plates and triangular and pentagonal surfaces on the rest of the head; handle narrows significantly toward the head and fits into oval hole; thin metal shim inserted on top of handle to tighten.</p> |  |
| 2005.11.27 | Hammer, Metalworking | <p>Octagonal metal head ends in circular strike face on one side and tapers a bit toward other, four of the sides are quite narrow and smaller end appears almost square; wooden handle is set into oval hole in head quite close to narrower end, thicker toward end and is almost totally wrapped with black tape.</p> |  |

| 2009.6.3 | Hammer | Spear & Jackson dog-head hammer with round wooden handle and octagonal steel hammer head; Hammer head flares and slightly tapers at both ends; Initials "E.B." punched in dots on one side, top of head stamped: "SOLID / CAST STEEL" on opposite side: "S*J / SPEAR&JACKSON / SHEFFIELD", and "HM C A" on another side; reddish hardwood handle widens toward end, has wide crack near head. |  |

| 2013.INV.276 | Hammer, Ball-Peen | <p>Ball-peen hammer with a dark-stained oak handle and steel head. Head has a rounded central section and the handle is secured at the top with a screw.</p> |  |
