The conference will include a keynote speaker, numerous breakout sessions, and an evening social.

Why present? There is a breadth of knowledge and experience in the Lower Mainland. The LMME conference depends on our community to participate. Submit a proposal to present at this year's LMME Conference, reflecting on Change Makers/ Space Makers. Key words to focus on include innovation, critical thinking, inclusivity, creative thinking, impact and/or social responsibility. How can museums promote change in the world? How can we create spaces and opportunities for positive changes within our organizations? What role do museums play in facilitating conversations/dialogue about contemporary issues in our community?

## PRESENTATION TYPES

- Ignite: A to-the-point, five minute presentation followed by a long discussion period. This session helps to create dialogue, foster learning, and is fun for all. Usually, the slides are timed and automatically advance: 20 slides of 15 seconds each.
- Workshop: Plan a hands-on, kinesthetic, or practical session that fills most of your time period. Share tools, practice skills, and make it memorable.
- Panel: Two or more speakers share the time equally, reflecting on topics that complement each other. Plan for a longer Q&A session so both speakers have a chance to interact with the audience.
- Individual Presentation: The session time is spent on one speaker and topic, followed by a short Q&A period. Share complex or sensitive topics in this type of presentation.
- Something else? We are open to ideas!

All sessions will be 25 or 50 minutes long.
